Scope of Requirements

The purpose of this Framework Agreement is to provide a compliant route to market for the provision of any or all elements of the Supply, Installation, management, maintenance and disposal of Data Centre Management Equipment & Data Centre Infrastructure plus data centre related design and Consultancy. The Maintenance and management of existing Data Centre Management equipment and Infrastructure is also included plus disposal including the removal and recycling of Data Centre Management equipment and Infrastructure. Equipment and or Infrastructure may be required to existing or brand-new Data Centre environments, for example for fit out, for refurbishment, for relocation or for upgrade purposes. Equipment and Infrastructure includes Uninterrupted Power Supplies, cooling equipment, generators, gas & fire suppression systems, PDUs, server & network racks, cabinets, blanking panels, building management equipment, monitoring equipment, modular and mobile data centre infrastructure, edge/micro data centre Infrastructure, plus equipment and infrastructure as part of modular or prefab units, containerised / pre-fab units.
